



DONOR PRIVACY

Crossroads United Way respects the privacy of our donors and is committed to protecting the personal information you share with us. We do **not** sell, trade, share, or rent donor information to any other organization, mailing list, or commercial entity.

Donor information is used solely to process contributions, communicate about our work, acknowledge gifts, and provide updates on programs and opportunities aligned with your interests. Access to personal information is limited to authorized staff, board members, and volunteers who require it to perform their duties and who are required to uphold strict confidentiality and ethical standards.

DONOR SECURITY

You can donate online with confidence at crossroadsuw.org/donate. Crossroads United Way uses reputable, industry-leading payment processors to securely handle credit card and electronic check (ACH) transactions. These partners manage the secure transmission of sensitive financial information through encrypted payment networks.

Our online donation systems comply with recognized industry security standards, including:

- Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) technology to protect data transmitted over the internet
- Advanced encryption methods and security protocols
- Compliance with the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS)

Crossroads United Way does not store full credit card numbers or banking information on our servers.

WEBSITE PRIVACY

Visitors may voluntarily provide personal information through subscription forms, event registrations, or donation pages. This information may include name, email address, mailing address, phone number, and areas of interest (such as Youth Opportunity or Financial Stability).

We do not knowingly collect or store sensitive personal information—such as Social Security numbers—through our general website. Information provided is used only for its intended purpose and in support of our mission.

INTERNET PROTOCOL (IP) ADDRESSES

When you visit our website, we automatically collect your Internet Protocol (IP) address. IP addresses are used for website administration, troubleshooting, analytics, and to better understand how visitors engage with our site. This information helps us improve user experience for individuals across Elkhart, LaGrange, Noble, and Steuben counties.



IP addresses are not linked to personally identifiable information.
